The participants of the third meeting were Sergio Fernandes, Ana Pinho, Altheo Valentini, Pieter van Schie, Alexandra Nikiforidou, Marios Vlachos, Aysun Akkan Memis, Lale Yildirimhan, Cigdem Isik, Koray Yeter, Ali Gunaydin, Ayfer Tasdemir, Anamaria Kasunic and Antonio Zapcic.

Before the meeting, the students from each country presented their own business ideas using powerpoint presentations and posters. The croatian students formed in three national subgroups presented their ideas first. Afterwards, the presentations continued with individual presentations from each student from Turkey, Greece and finally Portugal. The ideas and presentations were mostly widely different and unique from each other. There were ideas concerning the production of consumables like food and drinks, services like Airlines and everyday products like furniture and gadgets.

The location of the meeting was the school library in School of natural sciences in Karlovac, Croatia. The meeting took place during the morning and the afternoon of october 14th and 15th 2015. The meeting started after the students comenced their project activities in the separate room. The students were assisted by Matteo Martelli and Ognjen Andric.

The meeting started with the portugese partner elaborating and explaining the timesheet templates. Every component of the timesheets was discussed and explained to the partners. Partners inquired about the different elements and the proper way in which the timesheets should be filled out.

The portugese partner then continued with the topic concerning budgets and expenditures. The topic also oncerned the amounts of money to be claimed at certain project phases. After the short discussion and after all the partners agreed, the meeting moved on with the short summary of module 1.

The partners shortly discussed the previous phase of the project, module 1 and then moved on to the module 2 and the dissemination phase. The dutch partner explained the importance of social networking in the project, putting the emphasis on the Twitter. The online platform was also briefly discussed.

The meeting moved on with the topic of the next destination. The next meeting will take place in January 2016. in Xanthi, Greece. The partners discussed possible student number for the trip. It was agreed that the minimum of three students should suffice. It was also recommended that the students who will travel to Xanthi have the position of an administration manager in their own project subgroup. Also, there was a brief mention of the trip to Netherlands and Turkey and it was agreed that the more specific info will be issued during the meeting in Greece. Afterwards, the Italian partner gave the short explanation of the Florence conference.

Afterwards, the partners rejoined the students who formed transnational mixed groups and created new ideas or mixed the existing one. Every group contained students from every participating country. They proceeded to present the new ideas in the same way they did it before the meeting. The first group formed the idea for a gadget called "Mom's Assistant", the second mixed two ideas into one, creating "Vita-Berry Juices" project. The third and the fourth ideas were similar in step one, but quite different in elaboration, those two ideas concerned the luggage mixed in with electronic gadgetry, "Tech-bag" and "MUSTRA S.C."

After the meeting and after student presentations, the partners and students visited the memorial museum of Homeland war and had a short archery competition, supervised by the local historical archery club.
